The new disco Kasa da Praia in Foz do Douro occupies a former substation that used to supply electricity to the northern capital. In the 80s, the building was also the site of Colégio Luso Internacional. The disco features a restaurant and bar, VIP area and lounge.

#### Maus Hábitos

Not just a bar, a cafe, a restaurant, a gallery, or a stage, Maus Hábitos is a versatile and multifaceted cultural space that exudes a creative freedom you can really feel.

### Plano B

More than a bar, Plano B is an interdisciplinary space spread over two floors and a set of large rooms with different atmospheres. On Saturdays, the bar opens during afternoon to offer an excellent selection of high quality Portuguese products including wines, cheeses, jams, teas and other delicacies.
