PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 79/17, OF APRIL 24

Presidential Decree No. 79/17, of April 24, amends articles 2, 7 and 10 of Presidential Decree No. 43/17 of March 6, which establishes the applicable rules to the Exercise of the Professional Activity of Non-resident Foreign Employees. Presidential Decree No. 79/17, of April 24, amends articles 2, 7 and 10 of Presidential Decree No. 43/17 of March 6, which establishes the applicable rules to the Exercise of the Professional Activity of Nonresident Foreign Employees.

The update brought by this Presidential Decree, are as follows:

- The value and currency of remuneration may be freely agreed between the employer and employee, in compliance with the provisions of the General Labour Law and this Presidential Decree;
- The remuneration of the employee is paid in the currency agreed between the employer and employee, and can be paid in foreign currency;
- The payment of the employee's remuneration in cash must be made through a financial institution;

- The limitation of 50% on the base value to which the supplements and other benefits paid to the employee were subject, was eliminated, pursuant to Presidential Decree no. 43/17 of March 6;
- The duration of the employment contract is freely agreed between the employer and employee, and may be renewed for 2 (two) times, in accordance with the legislation in force.

The National Bank of Angola maintains the competence to define the amounts that may be transferred abroad, not having made any decisions yet in this regard.

This Presidential Decree come into force on April 25, 2017.
