

## **PROGRAM**

Sophisticated parties are sometimes reluctant to submit their disputes to courts in foreign jurisdictions, where laws, legal traditions, languages, customs, and cultural norms may be unfamiliar. As a result, international arbitration has emerged as the preferred way for parties to resolve international commercial disputes. However, successful arbitrations still require parties to agree upon the place of arbitration, the language of the proceedings, the procedural rules, and the governing law. Parties also must be prepared to persuade international arbitrators, who themselves may come from completely different legal traditions and cultural backgrounds. The theme of AtlAS's 7th Annual Conference is "Skills and Cultures: the Road Ahead for International Arbitration." The first day of the conference will feature four Tertulia sessions, which will focus on cultural norms in international arbitrations, and how those norms may be distinct in different parts of the world. The Tertulias will prime AtIAS conference participants for the next day of panels, which are dedicated to the "skills" useful in international arbitration and how those skills might differ depending on cultural considerations. 


